**HOLY PENANCE**

After the penitent has told his sins, whether venial or mortal, the priest answers with words of consolation and encouragement. Mortal sins are those of a grave matter, committed with full knowledge and full consent of the will; they must be confessed with the number of times committed. Sometimes, the priest must challenge the person to consider the state of his soul. The penitent, for his part, may ask for some clarification or some advice, which the priest will do his best to give. (Sometimes there may be a difficult question that the priest cannot answer immediately, since he needs to consult a better authority. This will mean that the penitent will have to return later.) When the priest is satisfied that he has understood everything he has heard and the penitent is finished with any questions, the priest prepares to give the penance, which will be explained next week.

**SAINT OF THE WEEK**

**15 April ~ Saint Hunna of Strassburg.** Hunna was born around the year 600, the daughter of a Duke of Alsace, the region of France that lies on the German border. When she was older, she was given in marriage to a nobleman named Huno; they had one son, Deodatus. Huno was often away, involved in the politics of the realm, so Hunna was left to manage his estate. She did this brilliantly and out of her wealth gave generously to the Church, endowing at least one monastery. She loved the Lord very much and devoted herself to caring for poor peasants, according to the words of Jesus himself, which had always struck her, "Whatever you did for one of these least ones, you did for me." She frequently visited the sick, bringing them food and carrying their laundry home to be washed and mended. The figure of the noblewoman Hunna wending her way through the streets bearing the threadbare rags of the poor in her laundry basket moved many hearts in Strassburg. They called her "the holy washerwoman." Upon her death in 679 the people immediately venerated her as a saint. She was canonized in 1520 and is the patroness of laundresses. Saint Hunna, pray for us!


