From Father Johnson

HOLY ANOINTING OF THE SICK

This sacrament brings to all who receive it four great effects: Firstly, the gift of the Holy Spirit to strengthen them and bring them peace. This is true of any sacrament, but especially of this one, because when we fall sick, we may feel weak and lose our peace of heart. Secondly, Holy Anointing unites us with the Passion of Christ. He shares our pain and makes it his own, uniting it to his Cross so that it becomes life giving even as we suffer. Thirdly, it is an ecclesial grace, meaning that we are united spiritually with the whole Church, drawing on the strength of the saints in heaven, and of our brothers and sisters on earth. The final effect is that it prepares us for the final journey. Holy Anointing "completes our conformity to the death and rising of Christ, just as Baptism began it . . . This last anointing fortifies the end of our earthly life like a solid rampart for the final struggles before entering the Father's house." To that we can all say, "Amen! So be it!"

SAINT OF THE WEEK

12 July ~ Saint John Gualbert: Born to a noble family in Florence, John was schooled in the ways of war from a young age. He was hotheaded and very violent. When his brother was murdered, he sought vengeance. One day, John encountered the murderer in a narrow alleyway. The man was unarmed. As John raised his sword to strike, the man sank to his knees and begged for mercy with his arms outstretched in the form of the Cross. The gesture so moved John that he put down his sword and forgave the man. Shortly thereafter, he entered the monastery of San Miniato to do penance for his sins of violence. After a while, he desired a stricter rule, so he journeyed to Vallombrosa, where he founded a new monastic house: his monks were to give themselves entirely to prayer and study. He was strict with his monks but generous to the poor who came to the gates. Even while he was alive, a number of miracles were attributed to him. He zealously defended the canon laws against greed and corruption in the Church, even fearlessly accusing the Bishop of Florence on this point. When he died in 1073, he had founded 50 monasteries in Italy alone. Saint John Gualbert, pray for us!
