The third spiritual work of mercy is to admonish sinners. How do we understand this? How can I set myself on a higher plane to preach to others, when I too am a sinner? The great preacher Father George Rutler tells us: "To admonish is not to accuse. Our Lord did not accuse the woman taken in adultery, but his merciful voice and consoling voice were a sufficient command for her correction. Jesus was bound and gagged when Peter denied him, unable to move or speak, but his mere glance was more powerful than a soldier's lance, piercing Peter's soul so that he wept." When love is the reason for our concern for the sinner, we can have an effect for the good. Another point to consider: what is sometimes called tough love is real love. When we exercise tough love, we are exercising true love, perhaps the truest love there is. We are admonishing the sinner because we love him.

**SAINT OF THE WEEK**

**1 April ~ Saint Nuno Alvares Pereira.** Nuno was born in 1360, the illegitimate son of Don Alvaro Pereira, a Knight of Saint John of Jerusalem. After receiving the rights of the nobility, young Nuno was sent to court and went to battle for the first time at age thirteen. He married a noblewoman, Leonor de Alvim, and together they had three children. Their daughter married the future King of Portugal. At age 23, Nuno was placed in charge of the army of Portugal. He committed himself to intense prayer and fasted three times a week in honor of Mary. Nuno was sometimes seen on his knees in the midst of battle. He even consecrated his sword to the Blessed Virgin. On 14 August 1385, his army defeated the Castilians at Aljubarrota, giving Portugal full independence from Spain. After the battle, Nuno retired to his castle overlooking the town of Fatima. He gave away vast amounts of his wealth to veterans, children and orphans, and fostered devotion to the rosary and the scapular. He built churches and a Carmelite friary in Lisbon. In 1422, he entered that same house as a lay brother. He spent the rest of his years in prayer and humble service of the poor. Brother Nuno of Saint Mary died on Easter Sunday, April 1 1431. He was canonized by Pope Benedict XVI in 2009. He is patron saint of those who suffer from arthritis. Saint Nuno, pray for us!
