**THE HOLY OILS**

The first holy oil we receive as Catholics is the Oil of Catechumens. Anyone present at a Catholic Baptism will have seen this oil used just before the baby (or adult) is baptized. It is the oil that seals in Christ, after Satan has been driven out or exorcized. The priest prays, just after the litany of the saints has been sung, "Almighty and ever-living God, you sent your only Son into the world to cast out the power of Satan, spirit of evil, to rescue man from the kingdom of darkness, and bring him into the splendor of your kingdom of light. We pray for this child: set him (her) free from Original Sin, make him a temple of your glory, and send your Holy Spirit to dwell with him. Through Christ Our Lord." Then the child is anointed on the chest. Satan has been driven out by the Prayer, and in his place, Jesus Christ has been sealed in, by the Oil of Catechumens. As he anoints, the priest or deacon says, "We anoint you with the Oil of Salvation in the name of Christ our Savior; may he strengthen you with his power, who lives and reigns for ever and ever. Amen."

**SAINT OF THE WEEK**

**29 May ~ Saint Bona of Pisa.** Bona was born about 1156 in Pisa, Italy. From the age of ten she pursued a life of assiduous prayer and experienced visions, most especially of the Apostle Saint James the Greater. When she was fourteen, she made the first of many pilgrimages, traveling to Jerusalem, where her father was fighting in the Crusades. On her return trip, Bona's ship was attacked by pirates, and she was taken prisoner. Some pilgrims from Pisa heard what had happened and sent the ransom. Bona made it back home undaunted and began immediately to plan her next trip, to the shrine of her beloved Saint James, in Compostela, Spain. From this time on, Bona devoted herself to pilgrimage as a tour guide. Eight times she led pilgrims on the thousand-mile journey from Pisa to Compostela, ever attentive to their needs. On her final journey, Bona became ill and could not continue. A local legend has it that this time, she traveled by air, transported to and from the shrine by Saint James himself. She died upon her return to Pisa. She is the patron saint of pilgrims. Saint Bona, pray for us!
